Each semester MAVA offers multiple OCED licensure courses and one MEd course. The MEd courses and schedule are listed below. You may take these courses through MAVA or you may take approved electives directly through FSU. A maximum of 6 graduate credits from another institution can be transferred into this degree. There is a **six year** window to complete this degree, with “the clock” beginning with the oldest course, including transfer courses.
